

William James Kembry
1886-1914

William Kembry was born in Weston-super-Mare. He was the 28 year old son of William and Mary Kembry from Bristol, and husband of Edith Cracknell who he married in Bristol in 1909.

A grocer's porter at Aylburton in 1911, and father of two children, Beatrice (1910), and William James (1914), he joined the Grenadier Guards at Bristol in 1914.

William was killed in Flanders on October 25th 1914 and is commemorated on the Ypres Menin Gate Memorial.

His widow Edith married Aylburton widower Thomas Hoskins, at Lydney in April 1919.
